

Notice of Liquidation

Oregon's Health CO-OP ("OHC"), an Oregon-based health insurer, was placed into liquidation by court order on March 2, 2017 after a determination that OHC was insolvent and could not be rehabilitated. The Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services serves as the Receiver for OHC. A copy of the court order can be viewed at <http://www.ohcoop.org/>. Coverage under all OHC policies was terminated as of July 31, 2016. OHC is not a member of any guaranty association and payments for any outstanding financial obligations will be limited to the remaining assets of OHC.

The liquidation order establishes a deadline for the submission of claims against OHC of September 30, 2017. Prior to the end of April 2017, the Receiver will mail to potential claimants a proof of claim form and instructions for filing a claim. Anyone that has not received a proof of claim form by May 1, 2017 who believes they have a valid claim against OHC may contact the Receiver at customersupport@ohcoop.org.
